4. It was moved by Mr. Grewal:

That the committee report Bill No. 71, *The Insurance Amendment Act, 2021* without amendment.

The question being put, it was agreed to.

That the committee report Bill No. 72, *The Life Leases Act* without amendment.

9. The question being put on clauses 1-1, it was agreed to.
10. During consideration of clause 1-2, it was moved by Mr. McLeod:

Strike out subsection (6) in Clause 1-2 of the printed Bill and substitute the following:

“(6) For the purposes of this Act, a body corporate is a wholly owned subsidiary of another body corporate if all of the membership interests of the first body corporate are held by one or both of:

(a) that other body corporate; or

(b) a wholly owned subsidiary, or wholly owned subsidiaries, of that other body corporate”.

Supprimer le paragraphe (6) de l’article 1-2 du projet de loi dans sa version imprimée et le remplacer par ce qui suit :

« (6) Pour l’application de la présente loi, une personne morale est une filiale en propriété exclusive d’une autre personne morale dans les cas suivants :

a) tous les intérêts de membre de la première sont détenus par cette autre personne morale;

b) tous les intérêts de membre de la première sont détenus par une ou plusieurs filiales en propriété exclusive de cette autre personne morale ».

The question being put on the amendment, it was agreed to.

The question being put on clause 1-2 as amended, it was agreed to.

11. The questions being put on clauses 2-1 to 22-9, they were agreed to.
12. It was moved by Mr. Keisig:

That the committee report Bill No. 75, *The Non-profit Corporations Act, 2021 / Loi de 2021 sur les organisations sans but lucratif* with amendment.

The question being put, it was agreed to.

13. The committee considered Bill No. 76, *The Non-profit Corporations Consequential Amendments Act, 2021*.

Amend Clause 2 of the printed Bill by adding the following subsection after subsection (2):

“(3) Subsection 1-2(6) is amended:

(a) in the portion preceding clause (a);

(b) in clause (a); and

(c) in clause (b);

by striking out ‘corporation’ wherever it appears and in each case substituting ‘body corporate’”.

The question being put on the amendment, it was agreed.

The question being put on clause 2 as amended, it was agreed.

16. The questions being put on clauses 3 to 25, they were agreed to.
17. It was moved by Mr. Grewal:

That the committee report Bill No. 76, *The Non-profit Corporations Consequential Amendments Act, 2021* with amendment.

The question being put, it was agreed to.
