Resolved, that there be granted to Her Majesty for the twelve months ending March 31, 2023, the following sums:

2021–22 Supplementary Estimates No. 2

The committee considered the following supplementary estimates no. 2 for the executive branch of government and adopted the following resolutions:

Resolved, that there be granted to Her Majesty for the twelve months ending March 31, 2022 the following sums:

Executive Branch of Government

For Corrections, Policing and Public Safety \$40,412,000

For Justice and Attorney General \$1,053,000

The committee recommends that upon concurrence of its report by the Assembly, the sums as reported and approved shall be included in the appropriation bill for consideration by the Legislative Assembly.
