Mr. Park: — Good morning, committee members. Welcome to your Public Accounts Committee meeting today. **The Chair:** — Thank you for that. I'm very happy to step into this role and looking forward to working with colleagues: my colleague from my side of the House, and from the government side, and looking forward to working with the staff.
