

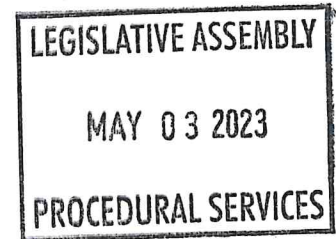

**Losses of Public Money
Boards Of Education Loss Report
Losses Reported by Boards of Education for the Period December 1, 2022 - February 28, 2023**

Date of Occurrence	Board of Education	Description	Amount	Action Taken
February-23	Horizon School Division	Fuel was stolen from school vehicle fuel tanks in Ituna and Punnichy.	\$ 3,043	The stolen fuel was reported to the RCMP and the school division's insurance provider. It is not yet known whether insurance will cover the loss.
January-23	Good Spirit School Division	A school division laptop was stolen from a hotel while an employee was on travel status.	\$ 1,200	A police report was filed. The laptop serial number was noted but it has not been found. When notified of the loss, the school division immediately and remotely changed the password on the laptop.
August-22	Northern Lights School Division	An employee inappropriately used a vehicle fleet credit card for personal use.	\$ 500	The employee was dismissed by the school division. Funds have not yet been recovered.
