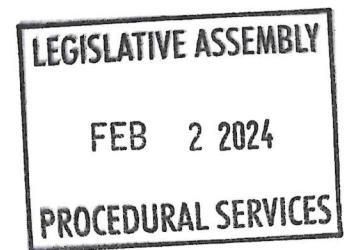

Date of Occurrence	Entity	Description	Amount	Action Taken
August 2023	Creative Saskatchewan ²	Banking information was fraudulently changed by someone impersonating a client. As a result, a payment was redirected to an inappropriate bank account.	\$331,568.80	The matter was reported to the police and is under investigation. To date, Creative Saskatchewan has recovered \$118,336.10.
2019 to June 2023 (preliminary estimate)	Saskatchewan Housing Corporation	Suspected misappropriation of funds for payments made to a fake vendor for work orders not completed.	In excess of \$5,000 (preliminary estimate)	A Cumberland House Housing Authority manager was terminated. The matter was reported to the police and is under investigation.

¹ Includes losses of money or property greater than \$500 that are due to fraud or similar illegal acts by employees, suppliers or contractors.

² While employee, supplier or contractor involvement is not suspected, given the loss is due to fraud and its significance, it is being reported.
