## Report of Public Losses for Ministries and Treasury Board Crowns<sup>1</sup> 2021-22 Second Quarter Report - for the Period July 1, 2021 to September 30, 2021

Date of Occurrence	Entity	Description	Amount	Action Taken
2016 and 2019 (discovered July 2021)	Ministry of Highways	Internal Audit discovered three instances where a Ministry employee received reimbursement for travel expenses from the Federal Government for out-of-province conferences in which the expenses were charged to a government-issued purchase card. The employee did not subsequently provide the reimbursements to the ministry until flagged by Internal Audit.		The employee was suspended for five days and transferred out of the program area. The entire amount of the loss was recovered from the employee.
October 2019 to April 2020	Ministry of Environment	An employee fraudulently submitted timecards that included time not worked.	\$4,366.77	The employee was terminated. \$3.113.33 has been recovered. The ministry is pursuing recovery of the remaining amount.
