January 2019 to September 2021	Saskatchewan Housing Corporation	The 2021-22 Third Quarter report included a preliminary loss of \$90,745 for misappropriated rent payments to a Housing Authority. A final investigation revealed the loss was \$92,564.	\$92,564 (previously reported as \$90,745)	A Beaver River Regional Housing Authority employee was terminated. The final investigation report was provided to the police and the Crown and charges are pending. An insurance claim was made for this loss with a deductible cost of \$50,000.
February 2022	Ministry of Corrections, Policing and Public Safety	Eight new cell phones were stolen from a Regina Community Correction's office. Confidential data was not compromised as the phones had not yet been issued to employees.	\$1,200	The matter was reported to the police. The perpetrator has not been identified. The Ministry is taking steps to better safeguard assets.
