The committee concurred with recommendation 7-1 made at page 94 of Chapter 7 (Liquor and Gaming Authority) of the 2006 Report of the Provincial Auditor (Volume 1) that the Liquor and Gaming Authority should formally assign responsibility for encouraging responsible use of beverage alcohol. The committee noted that the Liquor and Gaming Authority is making progress towards complying with the recommendation.

The committee concurred with recommendation 7-2 made at page 94 of Chapter 7 (Liquor and Gaming Authority) of the 2006 Report of the Provincial Auditor (Volume 1) that the Liquor and Gaming Authority should prepare a complete plan for encouraging responsible use of beverage alcohol. The committee noted that the Liquor and Gaming Authority is making progress towards complying with the recommendation.

The committee concurred with recommendation 7-3 made at page 95 of Chapter 7 (Liquor and Gaming Authority) of the 2006 Report of the Provincial Auditor (Volume 1) that the Liquor and Gaming Authority should continue to research and develop performance measures and targets to evaluate its performance in encouraging responsible use of beverage alcohol. The committee noted that the Liquor and Gaming Authority is making progress towards complying with the recommendation.
