### 2. Mr. Neudorf moved:

## 6. Mr. Lyons moved:

That the Public Accounts Committee recommend to the Legislative Assembly that the sittings of the Public Accounts Committee for the consideration of the Auditor's Report for the year-ending March 31, 1988 be held in the Legislative

Chamber and that the Clerk of this committee make the arrangements necessary with Mr. Speaker.

The Chairman suggested that the final phrase of the motion be deleted. The motion as altered was ruled to be in order. The motion reads:

That the Public Accounts Committee recommend to the Legislative Assembly that the sittings of the Public Accounts Committee for the consideration of the Auditor's Report for the year-ending March 31, 1988 be held in the Legislative Chamber.

During debate, the Chairman ruled certain expressions unparliamentary.

And debate continuing, the question being put on the motion, it was negatived.

Mr. Martens moved:

That in each instance where a private sector auditor has been given the responsibility to provide an audit for the Legislative Assembly under the Auditor's Act, that this auditor be required to attend as a witness for the Public Accounts Committee.
