That in each instance where a private sector auditor has been given the responsibility to provide an audit for the Legislative Assembly under the Auditor's Act, that this auditor be required to attend as a witness for the Public Accounts Committee.
4. And debate continuing, Mr. Lyons moved an amendment to add at the end of the motion:

and that other officials of corporations fully or partially funded by tax dollars, also may be summoned to appear before the Public Accounts Committee. And debate arising . . .
5. By unanimous consent, it was agreed that Mr. Muirhead take the Chair as Acting Chairman since Mr. Van Mulligen had to absent himself and Mr. Hopfner was speaking on the amendment.
6. Mr. Hopfner took the Chair.
7. The question being put on the amendment, and the result being equal, the Chairman voted in the negative. Accordingly, the amendment was negatived.

8. The question being put on the motion, and the result being equal, the Chairman voted in the affirmative. Accordingly, the motion was agreed to.
