REPORT OF THE LAW CLERK AND PARLIAMENTARY COUNSEL

to the

Standing Committee on Private Bills


I have examined this Private Bill and recommend that the above Bill and not proceed based on the following:

- The petitioners require further amendments to the legislation that were not included in the Printed Bill.
- The required amendments are beyond the scope of the bill as printed and therefore a new bill must be presented.
- The events that gave rise to the amendments that are now required were beyond the control of the private entity.

Pursuant to rule 109, I recommend suspending the rules respecting this private bill and that a new bill be introduced in the Assembly by April 13, 2022, and that when the bill is read a second time, it is committed to the Standing Committee on Private Bills.

And further, once the committee reports on the bill to the Assembly, the rules for Private Bills shall apply.
