Missing Sask. man's truck found in lake

A pickup truck that was recovered from a Saskatchewan lake on Sunday belonged to a 71-year-old man who has been missing for six months, according to RCMP.

The small truck was located under four metres of water in McLurg Lake, about 20 kilometres south of Pelican Narrows, Sask., on Friday.

RCMP divers confirmed on Sunday afternoon that the truck was that of James Joseph Gallagher of White Fox, Sask., who was reported missing on Nov. 4.

RCMP also said a body was recovered from the cab of the submerged truck, but the body has yet to be identified.

An autopsy has been scheduled for Tuesday in Saskatoon, at which time the identity will be confirmed, police said in a release.
